In July 2023, the University Alliance COLOURS (COLlaborative innOvative sUustainable Regional univerSities) was selected to be one of the 50 European University Alliances that will be funded by the European Commission as part of the prestigious "European Universities initiative – Partnerships for Excellence" for the next four years. Thereby, COLOURS will initiate and inspire social and technological innovation for citizens all over Europe.
