

For courses and exams offered in person (Face to face)
Documentation of necessity according to CoronaSchVO §6

Legal framework

Teaching and examinations at universities and health care schools are permitted in accordance with separate regulations in accordance with §28, para. 1 of the Infection Protection Act. Courses may only be admitted in presence if they cannot be carried out without attendance or postponed to a point in time after the 31st. January 2021 without serious disadvantages for the students or trainees. Face-to-face examinations and preparatory measures are only permitted if, for legal or factual reasons, they cannot be rescheduled to a point after the 31st. January 2021 or if a rescheduling is not reasonable for the examinees. (CoronaSchVo §6)

Date, time and place of the examination or course

Examination or course (course of study, module, form, possible title, name and e-mail address of the examiner(s) or lecturer(s))

Explanation why the course or exam cannot be postponed

Documentation must be submitted that the exam or course cannot be postponed to a point after the 31st of January without serious disadvantages for the student. This disadvantage, in particular, is assumed if there would be a considerable delay in the course of the study.
